Group Size/Active Credential Requirements

Data Highlighted in Red is Mandated in Sarasota County Ordinances

- For each of the group sizes listed above, appropriate staff to child ratios must also be maintained at all times.
- For **Mixed age groups** where all the kids are 2 years old and up – group size for majority population applies.
- For **Mixed age groups** that include children under 2 years old – group size for youngest population applies.
- Group sizes do not apply during **dining, specific large group assemblies/activities (special events), or outdoor play**, as long as supervision and ratios are maintained.
- Group sizes do not apply during **sedentary activities** for school-age only programs, as long as supervision and ratios are maintained.
- **Active credentials are a component of group size.** During the times/situations listed above when group size does not apply, the active credential requirement also does not apply.
- Active credential requirements also do not apply during times of **napping or sleeping**, as long as related supervision and ratio requirements are maintained.
- All new lead teachers will have one year from the start of employment to obtain an active credential. However, the new lead teacher must show documentation of enrollment in credential requirement courses within six months of employment.
- The active credential requirement goes into effect **October 25, 2018**.
